1 The Second Interim Fee Application of Krista L. Freitag ("Receiver"), Court-
2 Appointed Receiver, for Payment of Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses
3 ("Application"), Court-appointed permanent receiver for Defendants World Capital
4 Market Inc.; WCM777 Inc.; WCM777 Ltd. d/b/a WCM777 Enterprises, Inc.; and
5 Relief Defendants Kingdom Capital Market, LLC; Manna Holding Group, LLC;
6 Manna Source International, Inc.; WCM Resources, Inc.; ToPacific Inc.;
7 To Pacific Inc.; and their subsidiaries and affiliates ("Receivership Entities"), came
8 on for hearing on March 23, 2015. Appearances were as noted on the record.

9 The Court having received and read the Application, including any supporting
10 declarations and objections filed therein, and being so advised in the matter and
11 finding good cause, orders as follows:

12 **IT IS ORDERED** that the Receiver's Application is granted.

13 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Receiver's fees and costs for the
14 Second Interim Period are allowed and approved, on an interim basis, in the amounts
15 of \$163,422.90 and \$49,280.27, respectively.

16 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Receiver is authorized and directed to
17 pay herself \$130,738.32 in fees and \$49,280.27 in costs from assets of the
18 receivership estate, which amounts reflect an interim payment of 80% of the allowed
19 fees and 100% of the allowed costs.
