REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES**

On April 18, 2017, Krista L. Freitag (the "Receiver"), the Court-appointed permanent receiver for Defendants World Capital Market Inc.; WCM777 Inc.; WCM777 Ltd. d/b/a WCM777 Enterprises, Inc.; and Relief Defendants Kingdom Capital Market, LLC; Manna Holding Group, LLC; Manna Source International, Inc.; WCM Resources, Inc.; ToPacific Inc.; To Pacific Inc.; and their subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, "Receivership Entities") filed a Tenth Interim Fee Application for Payment of Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses ("Tenth Interim Fee Application"). On April 18, 2017, Allen Matkins Leck Gamble Mallory & Natsis LLP ("Allen Matkins"), general counsel to the Receiver, filed a Tenth Interim Fee Application for Payment of Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses ("Tenth Interim Fee Application"). On May 1, 2017, Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission (the "SEC") filed a Consolidated Response to the Receiver's Tenth Interim Fee Application and Allen Matkins' Tenth Interim Fee Application, advising the Court that it supported both Tenth Interim Fee Applications. No Opposition was filed. Pursuant to Rule 78 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Local Rule 7-15, the Court finds that these matters are appropriate for decision without oral argument. The hearing calendared for May 22, 2017 is

hereby vacated and the matters taken off calendar. After considering the Tenth Interim Fee Applications and the SEC's Consolidated Response, and the arguments therein, the Court rules as follows:

After carefully reviewing the detailed Tenth Interim Fee Applications, and in light of the SEC's support and the fact that no opposition was filed, the Court finds that the fees and costs were both reasonable and necessary to the administration of the estate. Accordingly, the Receiver's and Allen Matkins' Tenth Interim Fee Applications are **GRANTED**.

The Receiver's fees and costs for the Tenth Interim Period are allowed and approved, on an interim basis, in the amounts of \$174,249.45 and \$5,306.54, respectively. The Receiver is authorized and directed to pay herself \$139,399.56 in fees and \$5,306.54 in costs from assets of the receivership estate, which amounts reflect an interim payment of 80% of the allowed fees and 100% of the allowed costs.

Allen Matkins' fees and costs for the Tenth Interim Period are allowed and approved, on an interim basis, in the amounts of \$62,260.20 and \$4,405.29, respectively. The Receiver is authorized and directed to pay Allen Matkins \$49,808.16 in fees and \$4,405.29 in costs from assets of the receivership estate, which amounts reflect an interim payment of 80% of the allowed fees and 100% of the allowed costs.
